SIRM reveals new board and fixes November date for annual forum

The Swiss Association of Insurance and Risk Managers (SIRM) has elected Caroline Mott, insurance controller with international packaging firm Tetra Laval International, and Matthias Huber, risk and insurance manager with Swissport International, provider of ground and cargo handling services to the aviation industry, as new members of its committee.
