

Develop your career in risk

The 2018 FERMA / Lloyd's Professional Development Programme starts in April 2018. Risks managers from across Europe will be selected to take part in the three-part programme to better understand the Lloyd's (re)insurance market. So far more than 60 risk managers from 21 countries have attended the programme since it was launched in 2012.

A joint initiative between FERMA and Lloyd's, this programme focuses on practical activities that facilitate the exchange of experience between participants. It will give delegates the opportunity to :

- Gain a concise overview of the Lloyd's market, how it works and market trends.
- Experience a unique opportunity to shadow brokers and underwriters in the Lloyd's underwriting room.
- Gain insight into managing emerging risks, Lloyd's research and thought leadership.
- Join workshops or sessions on Lloyd's approach to risk appetite and management, exposure and performance management, as well as international insurance regulations.
- Take part in an interactive claims management session with Lloyd's claims experts.
- Grow connections through networking opportunities with underwriters, brokers, risk managers and Lloyd's Senior Leadership.

Who is the programme for ?

European risk managers of a FERMA national association.

How much commitment is required ?

The programme takes place across 3 x 2-day sessions over the course of 12 months, at Lloyd's London headquarters.

Before you apply please check you meet the entry criteria :

- 3 to 5 years risk management experience.
- European Risk & Insurance Manager or employed in the Risk Management department of an organization at the time of the first session of the programme
- Member of a FERMA national association
- Written and spoken business English skills.

- Travel to and from London and accommodation costs during sessions are born by the candidates or their employers as well as any other expenses incurred by the candidates.
- Lloyd's provides speakers, the venue and meals during the sessions.
- Coordinators for the content and execution of the programme are Ralph Mulder, FERMA Board Member, and Benno Reischel, Head of Europe for Lloyd's.
